Program

HURON training team conducted training in Nepalgunj of Banke on 1st November, 2017. The opening ceremony was started around 8:00 am in the morning and concluded at 10 am. The opening ceremony was chaired by Banke District Program Coordinator Mr. Pralhad Bahadur Karki and Chief Guest was HURON President Mr. Indra Aryal and other guests were HURON General Secretary, Political Members, and Representatives from Security personnel, NGOs, Metropolitan officers and Civil Society members. There were total 57 attendees during the inaugural ceremony.

Training session began right after the opening ceremony. There were total 50 participants where HURON members, Media Personnel, Security personnel (Nepal police and Armed Police Force), students, teachers etc. were attended. Out of 50 participants 8 were female and 42 were male.

The training templates which were distributed covered Fundamental Rights of Nepal, Civil Rights, Good Governance, Gentlemen's Agreement, International laws and Regulations and Treaties, Federalism, Crisis Management and Sustainable Development Goals.
